NOTICE OF COMPLETION PROPOSED ASSESSMENT REPORT

Niagara Peninsula Source Protection Committee (NPSPC) has completed the *Proposed Assessment Report (AR)* as required under the Clean Water Act, 2006. The *Proposed Assessment Report* is a summary of all the technical reports and studies that have been completed under the Source Protection program to-date. The information in this report will provide the basis for developing the Source Protection Plan to protect municipal drinking water sources in Niagara. A key item in the report is the delineation of vulnerable areas and identification of drinking water threats in these areas.

Public comments received during the previous public consultation period are reflected in the *Proposed Assessment Report*.
