Regarding timelines, October 2008 is the deadline to complete the Terms of Reference and that will include all public and municipal consultations. The Draft Terms of Reference must be ready for presentation to the SPA by August, 2008.

Tony D'Amario advised that a report including milestone information will be presented to the SPC at next months meeting.

David Kerr noted that a summary of local activities where Source Protection Committee activities could be discussed would be informative for the members (e.g. symposiums, club activities). The Chair concurred that this was an excellent idea and if any staff or member has a similar idea to bring it forward. Another educational opportunity might be a tour of a treatment plant.

Robert Bator asked if he could get the GPS coordinates for the Water Treatment Plant intake locations so he could find the locations on Google Earth. Brian Wright is to locate the information.

Maria Bellantino Perco inquired about a presentation or primer on technical reports. Brian Wright will look into this.

Dean Ostryhon advised that Niagara Navigator has ortho imaging available which includes colour photos of each intake. Brian advised that Grimsby and Fort Erie are out in the lake but the other four intakes might have good ortho imagery.
