DECLARATION OF CONFLICT OF INTEREST

ADOPTION OF AGENDA

BUSINESS:

(2) <u>BUSINESS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES</u>

Mr. Rigby had wondered why modeling wasn't included in urban areas for St. Catharines and Niagara Falls, yet the urban areas in Port Colborne were modeled. Brian Wright explained that St. Catharines and Niagara Falls urban areas essentially covered the whole watershed planning area versus Port Colborne which only covers a portion of the watershed planning area.

Mr. Renshaw questioned the change of flow in the winter months compared to during the shipping season. The flows were lower in the winter months, so it is a more reasonable and conservative approach to use the summer flows.

(3) UPDATE OF SOURCE PROTECTION WORK SCHEDULE

After a review of the remaining tasks to complete the Assessment Report, it was suggested the committee take this report to the MOE to request an extension. The Chair explained there were many factors contributing to falling behind on the aggressive schedule. To avoid non-compliance, he is confident the committee request NPCA staff can complete the appropriate paperwork to get the timeline extended.

The Chair asked for endorsement from the committee to submit the new work plan and request an extension from the minister.

Mr. Renshaw requested that the consultation period with staff at local municipalities be shown on the chart.
